#### What to do



#### Park your car at a safe spot

#### Clean drainage and gutters

Report any issue in plumbing systems to the maintenance team for resolution to prevent blockages caused by debris and waste.



#### Trim vegetation

Prevent overgrowth, which may block drainage systems. Also, dispose of plant waste to avoid obstruction in drainage.



# Inspect windows, roofs and ceilings

Repair damages to prevent water from entering your property.



#### Store away outdoor furniture

Strong winds can easily cause damage, posing a risk to your property and neighbouring areas.



#### Secure house against moisture

Ask a professional to inspect and rectify any vulnerabilities or damage points to anticipate leaks. Close water pump chambers too.





#### Check air conditioners

Routinely service and inspect AC units to ensure optimal functionality and drainage.



#### Inspect water heaters

Check for leaks, corrosion, and sediment buildup and undertake necessary maintenance measures.



#### Work remotely

Avoid unnecessary outside exposure and work from the comfort of your home to avoid accidents and damage to your vehicle.

# Drive through waterlogged or flooded areas

Even shallow water can stall your engine and cause severe, often irreversible, damage.



# Turn on ignition of a submerged vehicle

This could potentially damage your vehicle's electrical circuitry, control modules, and the engine.



# Leave electrical points exposed

Take off all unnecessary equipment, appliance, and stay away from power lines as this can be extremely dangerous.
